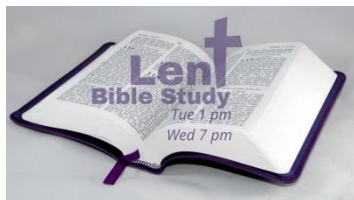
On the Road Again

RCRG is excited to announce that they're re-launching their Transportation service on a limited basis. "Limited" because COVID-19 is still very much part of our daily lives, and for the service to be useful, it first has to be safe.

Right now, seniors are able to request rides within Richmond, with priority being given to medical appointments. For every trip, RCRG volunteer drivers will use RCRG's agency vehicle - a 2020 Nissan Rogue that's been outfitted with a plexiglass barrier between the front and back seats. Clients will ride in the back - just like an Uber - with the barrier separating them from the driver.

Also, as an additional safety measure, clients must be able to transfer in and out of the vehicle independently. This will further minimize contact between clients and drivers.

The service is available to any senior living in Richmond, and of course, family members and caregivers can schedule rides on a senior's behalf. To register, or to request more information, call RCRG at **604-279-7020**.
