VCH COVID-19 Vaccination Survey

As more British Columbians become eligible to receive a COVID-19 vaccine, Vancouver Coastal Health (VCH) is launching a brief survey and asking people in our communities about the COVID-19 vaccine information they need most as they book a vaccine appointment and receive their vaccine at a clinic as well as whether they plan to get a COVID-19 vaccine. The learnings will help ensure VCH is providing the most relevant materials about the COVID-19 vaccination program to our communities. The survey consists of only five questions and takes up to five minutes to complete.
