Bio: The Rev. Dr. Glen Davis is Minister-in-Association at Kerrisdale Presbyterian Church. Glen has had an active and varied ministry within the Presbyterian Church for many decades. He and his wife Joyce ministered together in the Korean Christian Church in Japan for 15 years. Glen also served in the national office of the PCC for 18 years, in Mission and Education, International Ministries and was the first General Secretary for the Life and Mission Agency. He was elected as Moderator of the 126th General Assembly in the year 2000. Glen and Joyce also ministered together at Knox Presbyterian Church in Scarborough. Glen has been active with both St. Andrew's Hall in Vancouver and the Presbyterian College in Montreal in Presbyterian formation. Currently, Glen serves as co-convenor of the Community Engagement Committee of the Presbytery of Westminster.
