Jean is a graduate of Brock University (BA), Princeton Theological Seminary M.Div), Vancouver School of Theology (Th.M), and she has Advanced Standing in Clinical Pastoral Education with the Canadian Association of Spiritual Care. In 2010, Jean was awarded the degree of Doctor of Divinity (honoris causa) from the Vancouver School of Theology. Jean has served the wider church in a variety of roles, including her election as Moderator of the 131st General Assembly of the Presbyterian Church in Canada in 2005. She is currently the Board Chair at St. Andrew's Hall and also serves on the Board of the Vancouver School of Theology.
