Today we have the honour to listen to Rev. Dr. Dale Woods as he preaches on finding wisdom for the challenges of life.



**Bio:** Rev. Dr. Woods is the Presbyter for Mission and Vision in the Presbytery of Westminster, B.C. Prior to taking that position in 2020, he was Principal of The Presbyterian College, Montreal, one of the three theological colleges in Canada. He

joined Presbyterian College in 2008 as the Director of Pastoral Studies and was appointed Principal in 2015. He holds degrees from the University of Alberta (B.A.), Regent College, Vancouver (MATS), the Vancouver School of Theology (M.Div.), and Luther Seminary, St. Paul (D. Min.). Prior to his work at Presbyterian College, Dr. Woods served for nearly fourteen years at First Presbyterian Church, Brandon, Manitoba. It was his first congregation following his ordination in 1994 and a congregation from whom he learned much. His main interest of study is in leadership. He is married to his wife Susan and they have two adult children, David and Sarah.
