The Board wishes to thank everyone who has so faithfully supported the congregational budget in this very trying year.

Total offerings as of 31 October were \$194,800. Total other revenue including investments were \$115,000 for a total of \$309,800. In the same period expenses were \$313,500, for a difference of \$3,700.

As we approach the end of the year the Board will provide another update so we may rejoice in God's blessings upon us. Thank you.
