The financial update for the month ending November 30, 2022: Revenue from 'Givings' is \$ **40,197** below budget. Other revenue is \$ 10,489 above budget. Overall, the revenue is approximately \$ **29,708** less than the anticipated budget. Expenses to November 30th are \$ **5,536** over budget. As of November 30th, there is a deficit of \$ **4,427** versus an anticipated surplus of \$30,816.
