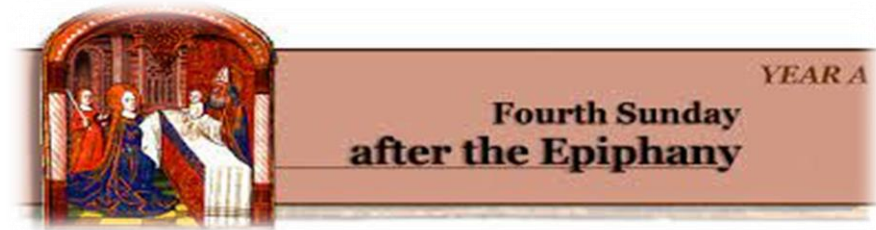


Richmond Presbyterian Church
