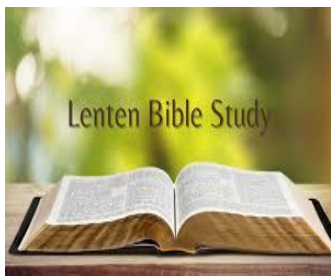
Children and youth are invited for faith formation to room 3 after the Scripture Reading.
