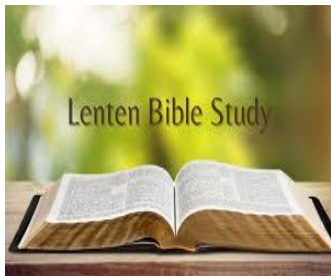
Deep with God, Wide with the World
