"I was born in Goderich, Ontario but spent most of my life living in Hamilton. My legal name is Malcolm, but my paternal grandmother said that Malcolm is too old for a baby – use the Gaelic equivalent Calum, that's how I'm known. After having taught for 27 years, I finally answered the call to ministry and entered Knox College in 1998. It was going to be an adventure with three children and myself in university, but we managed. In 2002, I was called to Gordon Presbyterian Church. I've spent 22 years as a minister of word in sacrament, 20 at Gordon Presbyterian Church and two at Trinity Presbyterian Church (an amalgamation of Gordon, Knox and St Aidans Presbyterian churches). I retired for ministry January 1, 2025 and began another adventure – retirement..."
