Quarter 2 Financial Update (Summary to June 30, 2025) — This quarterly financial update provides an overview of our church's financial performance to the end of the second quarter, June 30th, 2025. We are grateful for the congregation's financial support of the ministry and mission of our church. Givings continue to fall short of the financial commitment the congregation approved at the **2025 Annual Congregational Meeting**. As of June 30, 2025 Givings are **\$ 26,503** behind. Per the approved budget, the Legacy Fund is contributing \$ 68,000 over the course of the year, \$ 20,000 of which is reflected below in the "Other Revenue" line. Even with the \$ 68,000 for the year, the budget still had a \$ 24,000 deficit. If the trend in Givings continues this deficit could triple. **Please prayerfully consider increasing your Givings to meet the commitment made at the Annual General Meeting.**
