Be part of a beautiful worship experience with our 4-week Summer Chimes Choir! We'll be playing easy, uplifting worship songs.



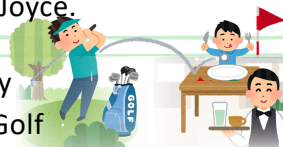
