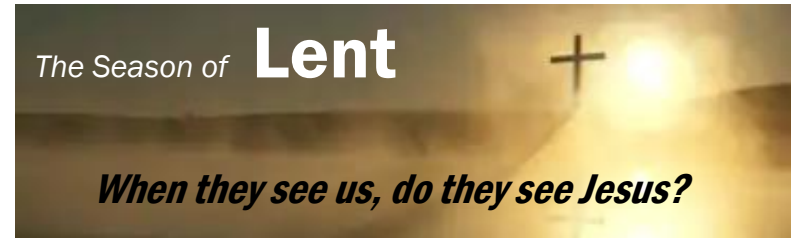


Welcome to Richmond Presbyterian Church

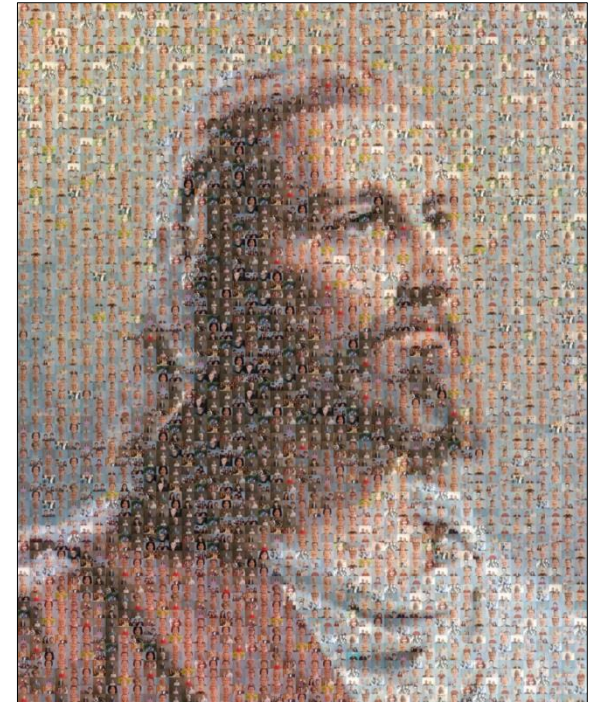
